1. As we enter into the 3rd week of the Movement Control Order (MCO), I hope that all of you are as safe and well as possible. As our routine lives continue to be transformed, please be mindful to maintain your health, both physically and emotionally. 2. The National Security Council has tightened their standard operating procedures and stricter rules have been put in place. In tandem, we have seen a rise in the number of roadblocks and arrests of civilians deemed to have flouted the MCO rules. Please take the repeated government warnings seriously as criminal convictions will have a significant impact on your immediate and future lives. International students may risk losing their student visas should they be found guilty of any charges under the Malaysian law. The Government of Malaysia also recently announced the Bantuan Prihatin Nasional (BPN) stimulus package to help mitigate the devastating economic impact of COVID19 and support individuals who are most in need.
