Special Announcement: Updates on Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO)

1. The Prime Minister of Malaysia announced on 10 May 2020 that the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) will be extended to 9 June 2020. The CMCO signals an easing of the partial lockdown that was implemented since 18 March 2020 to contain the COVID-19 pandemic. Nevertheless, we were reminded that the threat of COVID-19 infections remains high and we have to still maintain all the various safety measures such as physical distancing. 2. It was announced that schools and higher education institutions will remain closed for their primary function; i.e. face-to-face classroom instruction. Sunway College Kuching's campus is closed and will remain closed up to the end of the government's CMCO which is to minimise the spread of Covid19 infection. **Students should not come to the campus and there will be no teaching. The library and teaching and learning facilities on campus will not be available. Thus, teaching and learning will continue to be conducted fully online throughout the entire semesters and as for now, there will be no physical face-to-face educator student classes allowed because of on-going uncertainty regarding the global healthcare situation in line with Ministry of Higher Education's circular dated 27 April 2020 reference number JPT(A)1000/001/019/01 Jld.20 (75).**
3. From 19 May 2020, staff will be allowed to return to campus to work on a needs basis. This is to primarily facilitate the preparations for the eventual opening of the campus, upon the lifting of the CMCO, currently scheduled for 9 June 2020. The need to return to work at campus during CMCO will be determined by the Chief Executive Officer. It is very important that physical distancing and other safety measures are applied.
4. We have also developed some immediate general guidelines and standard operating procedures for all the designated staff who will be coming in to campus during this period
